MONTHLY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2019

SUBMITTED BY DISTRICT LEVEL SPECIAL TASK FORCE

The 11th Meeting of District Level Special Task Force was held on 17.07.2019. Sh. Vivek Pandey, Scientist 'B', Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee informed that DLSTF had already conducted the inspections of Sukhna Choe & N-Choe and Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has been directed to take necessary action. Further, he informed that 02 field visit have also been conducted to check the industries w.r.t. ETP.

Thereafter, the status of all the discharge points of Sukhna Choe and N-Choe were discussed.

2. Status of Tenders w.r.t. upgradation of STPs and construction of new STPs

Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has informed that due to change in Phosphate Concentration for STP Outlets by Hon'ble NGT, they have to retender to include the same in specifications, which will take some time. They are in the process of changing technical specifications w.r.t. phosphate.

3. Status of installation of Flow Meters at Drains

Sh. Rajinder Singh, S.E. Engg. Deptt., Chandigarh Administration informed about the installation of flow meters at drains. He submitted that survey has been done at the respective

points and it is found that there are technical difficulties being faced in installation of flow meter, as there are no definite discharge points. However, he assumed that he will do the needful after consulting the officers of other States for a possible solution.

4. Status of Action taken by Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh regarding noncompliance of existing STPs.

Sh. Vivek Pandey, Scientist 'B' informed that in the month of June out of 05 STPs, 02 STPs are not meeting with the prescribed norms. Sh. Ishwar Dutt Sharma, Executive Engineer, Municipal Corporation Chandigarh informed that due to very old infrastructure at STPs they are facing problem in maintaining the norms, however, they are trying their best to treat the waste water as per the norms. Further he also informed that Maloya STP is operational now.

Sh. Ishwar Dutt Sharma, Executive Engineer, Municipal Corporation Chandigarh informed that due to breakage in line which carries waste water to Diggian STP, presently Diggian STPs is not operational and it will take 2-3 months for repairing of the same. Chairman directed Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh to take necessary steps to repair the same at the earliest.

5. Status of Action Taken by MC, Chandigarh regarding stoppage of untreated discharge of waste water into Choes.

Sh. Ishwar Dutt Sharma, Executive Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh informed that they are already in process and most of the points have already been tapped and for the rest process is under progress.

6. Regarding Organisation of Health Camps:

Ms. Shobhna Pathania, Nodal Officer, Health Deptt., UT, Chandigarh has informed that Chandigarh is having good number of dispensaries in villages and regular check up of residents is being done there. However, as per the directions they will conduct health camp on 31st July, 2019.

Further, Sh. Vivek Pandey, Scientist 'B' informed that CPCC is in process to initiate suitable action on non complying industries.
