

MONTHLY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2019

SUBMITTED BY DISTRICT LEVEL SPECIAL TASK FORCE

The 14th Meeting of District Level Special Task Force was held on 30.9.2019 under the Chairmanship of SDM (Central) in D.C. Office, Chandigarh to discuss the action taken to control the pollution in river Ghaggar.

1) Status of tenders w.r.t. upgradation of STPs and construction of new STPs.

Sh. Gagandeep Singh, Manager, Chandigarh Smart City Limited, informed that the tender for up gradation of existing STPs and construction of new STP has been re-invited on 23.9.2019, due to some technical issues. The last date of submission of technical bids is now 14.10.2019.

Ms. Nazuk Kumar directed Smart City officials that in any circumstances work should be completed by Nov. 2021 as per the action plan submitted to Hon'ble NGT.

2) Status of plugging of various points of Sukhna choe and N-choe.

Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh provided the status of discharge of untreated waste water in N-Choe, Sukhna choe and Faida choe which is as given below:

5) Regular inspection of industries by CPCC so as to take action against the defaulting units.

Sh. Vivek Pandey informed the committee that inspections of industries are being done regularly and actions are being taken as per the findings.
