**Roles and Responsibilities**

1. The committee will oversee and supervise the activities of various missions and Knowledge Management Centre and Secretariat of State Action Plan on Climate Change, Chandigarh and will provide necessary guidance for effective functioning..

2. The committee will meet atleast twice every year to review the progress of the State Action Plan on Climate Change, Chandigarh.
3. The committee will approve the annual action plan on climate change
4. The committee will appoint a review committee for technical review of the State Action Plan on Climate Change, Chandigarh for every three years and will issue directives as per the observations/recommendations of the review committee.
5. Review the progress of the action plan based on the monitoring protocol developed by the monitoring and evaluation cell
6. Guide the monitoring and evaluation cell for development of the monitoring protocol
7. Seek guidance from the National Action Plan for Climate Change on various technical matters from time to time.
8. Recruit various missions and members under the mission of the State Action Plan as and when necessary
9. Seek financial support for State Action Plan from the Central Government or other donor agencies whenever necessary
10. Facilitate inter- ministerial/departmental coordination for effective implementation of the action plan.
