Point 4: Details of Plastic Waste Management (PWM) e.g. Collection, Segregation, Disposal (Co-Processing, Road construction, etc.) Rules (5 & 6). (Attach Action Plan)

The Municipal Solid waste is collected by the door to door collectors, engaged by the Resident Welfare Associations, NGOs and Private Operators and these door to door collectors have been integrated by MC Chandigarh and occupation certificate has been issued to them. They have made two compartments in their cycle's rickshaw carts to keep the wet and dry garbage in separate compartments. Thereafter, these door to door collector's further do the sorting of useful components from the Municipal Solid Waste i.e. plastics, metals etc. and further transport it through their cycle rickshaw carts to the various bins/sehaj safai kendras located in the city. The recyclable plastic is sorted by door to door collectors and sells to the private vendors at their own as such the quantity off recycle plastic waste cannot be assessed.

Point 5: Partial/complete ban on usage of Plastic carry bags (through Executive Order)

Chandigarh Administration has imposed complete ban on the use of plastic carry bags vide notification no. ED/2008/684 dated 30.07.2008. After implementation of the PWM Rules, 2016 CPCC has allowed compostable carry bags certified by CPCB and are complying with the norms of PWM Rules, 2016. Further, it is mentioned that as per the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) order dated 04.12.2015 in O.A. No. 442 titled as R.D. Anand Vs. Chandigarh Union Territory Administration & Anr., "directed that any person who is found to be using, storing, purchasing, dealing with or distributing plastic bags, plastic plates or plastic glasses and such allied items shall be liable to pay environmental compensation at the rate of Rs. 5000/per event." and in the order dated 20.01.2016 "completely prohibit use of plastic, manufacturing, storing and/or any kind of plastic carry bag(s) including Non-woven material of Poly propylene 100% & Non-Biodegradable plastic bag(s) in the Union Territory of Chandigarh."

It is further informed that Chandigarh Administration Notification No. ED/2019/1648, dated 27.09.2019 has banned Single Use Plastic/ Thermocol Items (Notification copy attached as Annexure II). And in the partial modification of the above said notification, Chandigarh Administration vide Notification No. ED/2020/247, dated 01.07.2020 has kept the items with serial no. 16 to 18 of the said notification under Extended Producer Responsipility (EPR) instead of the ban list. (Notification copy attached as Annexure III)
